



Welcome to InClass!

What is InClass?

InClass is PAUSD's on-line communication tool. It is a place on the web where teachers can post homework, projects, links and announcements for students. Teachers can also use some of the advanced features including posting of grades, class bulletin boards and chat rooms.

What do I need to Access InClass?

InClass is available any time, anywhere. If you have access to the world wide web, you have access to InClass. You can see what your teacher has posted if you are at home, across the country or on the other side of the world!

How do I access InClass?

To access InClass, go to: <http://k2.pausd.org> You can also find a link to InClass on the Gunn High School main web page, <http://gunn.pausd.org>.

Log in with a user name that is your student ID number. Your password is initially set to your student ID number.

How can I change my password or put my e-mail address in InClass?

Once you are in InClass, click on the "Personal Information" in the column on the left side of your screen. Here you can change your password or click on "Edit Personal Information" to edit your e-mail address.

How can my parents access InClass?

Your parents can log in too. (You may have to help them the first time.) They have their own "observer" account. Their user name is your student ID number followed by an underscore and a p. (ex: xxxxxx_p) and their password is your student ID. They can also change their password.

What if I have trouble accessing InClass?

If you don't know your student ID number, check your student ID card. You will see an 8 or 9 digit number that is your ID number. If you still need help, ask your counselor or stop by RC-1 at lunch or brunch and we will be glad to look it up for you.
